INTRODUCTION

The Peking to Paris Motor Challenge is more than a rally – it's a life-changing adventure. As the world's longest-running and most prestigious motoring endurance event, it proudly upholds its legacy to this day.

Our mission is to preserve the essence of this extraordinary journey, even as the world around us evolves. To do so, we chart a course through the most remote and unspoiled regions, ensuring that the 'time travel' experience remains vivid for all who take part.

Given the demanding nature of the event, we are highly selective in our entry process. Participation is reserved for experienced crews who have competed in other HERO-ERA events in preparation for the ultimate challenge. A true spirit of adventure is essential – expect to camp under the vast skies of Mongolia and Kazakhstan and carry out regular maintenance on your own vehicle.

With average daily distances of 400 kilometres – and some days stretching to 650 kilometres – this is endurance rallying at its finest. Only those with the grit, skill, and determination to conquer one of the toughest rallies on Earth need apply.

APPROVAL PROCESS FOR ENTRIES

Every entry application will be subjected to the approval process upon receipt of deposit.

APPROVAL CRITERIA

Entries will be considered based on the following criteria:

- 1. Car Type Preference is given to rare vehicles and those with a documented history.
- 2. Car Age Older vehicles will be prioritised; Pioneer > Vintage > Open Top Vintageant > Vintageant > Classic > Modern Classics.
- 3. Crew Experience Teams with previous long-distance rally experience with HERO-ERA will be given preference.
- 4. Medical Professionals Medics, doctors, and nurses will receive priority consideration.
- 5. Membership Requirements Premier Membership is compulsory, with Heritage Members receiving priority.

We appreciate all applications and aim to create a well-balanced, experienced and diverse entry list.

DECLARATION OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND INDEMNITY WHICH MUST BE SIGNED AND DATED BY ALL PARTICIPANTS

This is a legal document issued by HERO Events Ltd ("the Promoter") and by signing it you acknowledge and agree to its terms. It is to be construed under the law of England and Wales.

I agree to be bound by the official regulations and any supplementary regulations issued by the promoter, HERO Events Ltd, for the event referred to on the front sheet, hereinafter referred to as the Event.

In consideration of my being permitted to take part in the Event, I agree to hold harmless and keep indemnified the promoter and /or such persons or bodies as may be authorised by it to promote or organise or who may assist in promoting or organising the Event and its respective officials, servants, representatives and agents, motor clubs, overseas travel agencies and all associated organisational bodies, landowners and other participants in the event from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death or personal injury and damage to any property arising out of or in connection with my taking part in the Event. By signing this disclaimer below, I agree that in the absence of any negligence or other breach of duty by the promoter and / or such persons or bodies as may be authorised by it to promote or organise or who may assist in promoting or organising the Event and its respective officials, servants, representatives and agents, motor clubs, overseas travel agencies and all associated organisational bodies, landowners and other participants, including for personal injury caused by their acts or omissions, participating in the Event is entirely at my own risk and the promoter and the other listed parties' liability, howsoever arising, is excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I confirm that I will have insurance in place for the duration of the event covering my liability to others (to include compulsory insurance required by the territories through which the event passes) and adequate medical expenses and repatriation cover in respect of my own circumstances. I declare that I do not suffer from any disability which whilst i am driving any vehicle on the event is likely to adversely affect my control of that vehicle given the nature of the event and the route.

In the entry form and these terms and conditions, a 'force majeure event' means any circumstance not within the promoter or local organisers' reasonable control including without limitation acts of God, freak weather conditions, flood, drought, earthquake or other natural disaster, collapse of buildings, fire, explosion or accident, epidemic or pandemic, terrorist attack, civil war, civil commotion or riots, war, threat of or preparation for war, armed conflict, imposition of sanctions, embargo, or breaking off of diplomatic relations, closure of borders or threat of closure of borders, nuclear, chemical or biological contamination or sonic boom, any law or any action taken by a government or public authority, including without limitation imposing an export or import restriction, quota or prohibition, or failing to grant a necessary licence or consent. If the promoter is prevented, hindered or delayed in or from performing any of its obligations under this agreement by a 'force majeure event' it shall not be in breach of this agreement or otherwise liable for any such failure or delay in the performance of such obligations. If the force majeure event prevents, hinders or delays the promoter's performance of its obligations under this is agreement, and is in the promoter's opinion likely to prevent it from running the Event as planned, it may terminate this agreement on written notice to the entrant(s).

I understand that, in order to participate in this Event, both driver and co-driver must each hold a minimum of Premier Membership.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

To confirm your entry, the full, non-refundable and non-transferable deposit, subject to the T&C of this form and Heritage Membership, must be paid. Applications without a paid deposit will not be considered by the Approval Committee.

If the Event is cancelled before it begins due to a force majeure event, all payments made will be refunded, less 25%, which will be retained to cover costs and expenses incurred by the Promoter. By agreeing, you confirm that this retention is reasonable and proportionate to protect the Promoter in fulfilling the agreement.

Should you withdraw from the Event at any time, either before or after it starts, for any reason, all payments made to the Promoter will remain non-refundable and non-transferable. However, if you are a current Heritage Membership holder and choose to withdraw on or before the specified withdrawal date, you may either transfer 100% of funds paid to a different eligible event or receive a 75% refund on the deposit, with the remaining balance transferred towards a future event.



DRIVING TO THE CONDITIONS (DTTC)

Driving Standards and Safety

I, the undersigned competitor, acknowledge that I am required to adhere to realistic driving standards during the Event at all times. These will depend on road conditions, including traffic and weather-related factors. I understand that it is solely my responsibility to judge the conditions and the capabilities of my vehicle in any weather and/or any other factors encountered during the Event.

I understand that the organisers do not encourage or compel me to exceed my personal driving abilities or the capabilities of my vehicle, even in competition. I further acknowledge that my participation in the Event must always respect all applicable road safety laws, and that I am directly responsible—not the organisers—for operating my vehicle within safe and legal limits at all times, including during competition.
